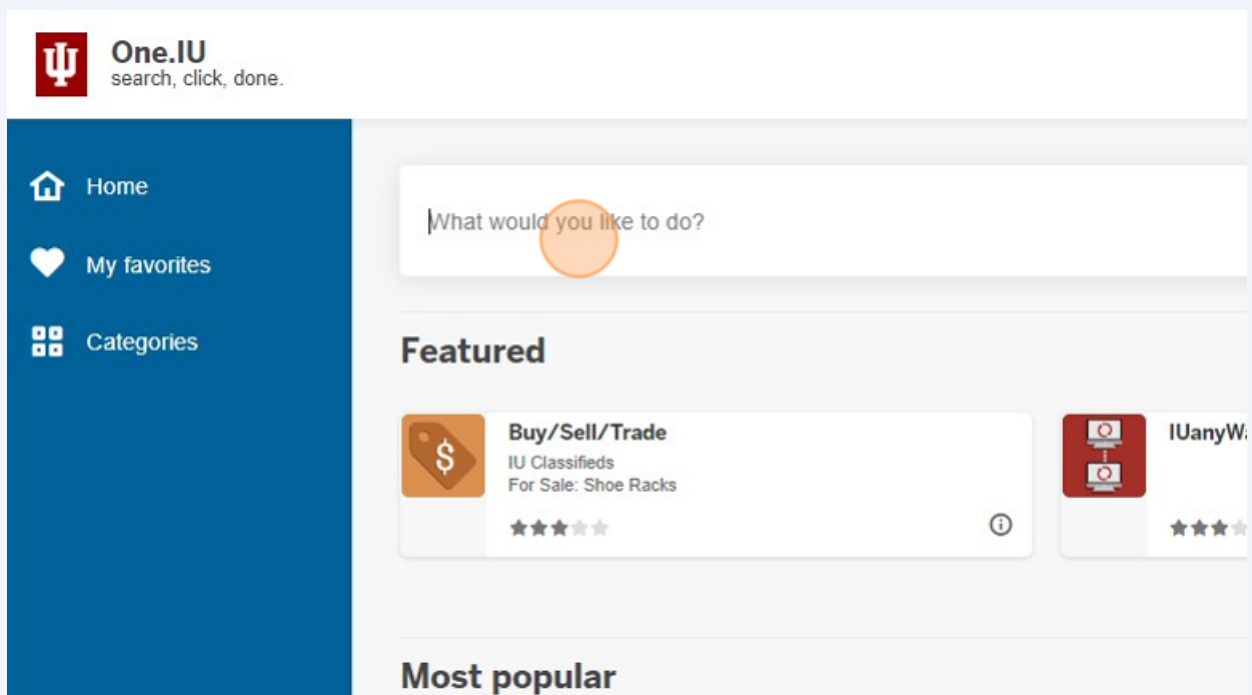

2 Search for "IU Scholarships" in the Search Bar



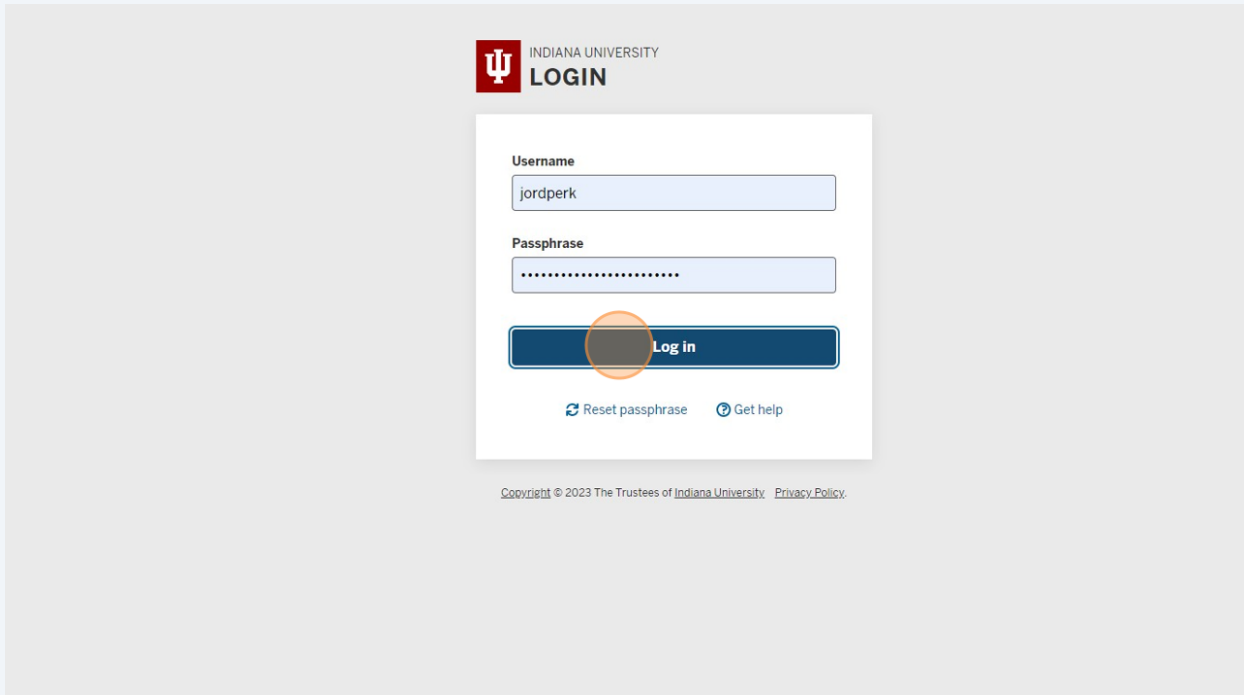
